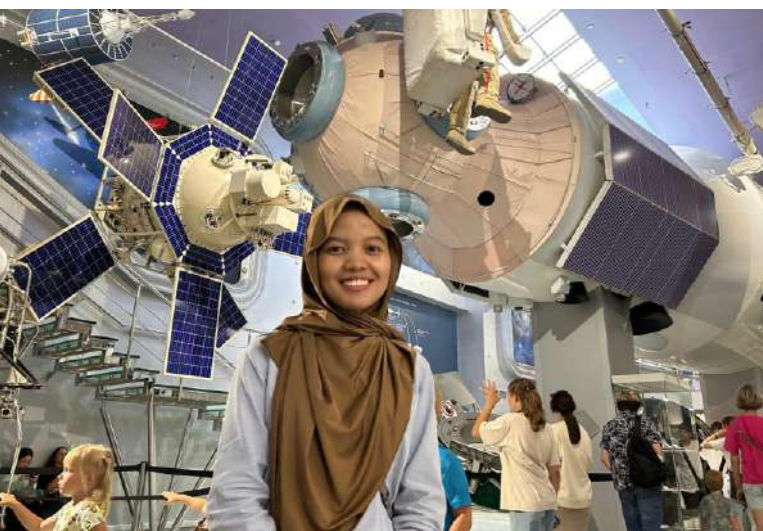
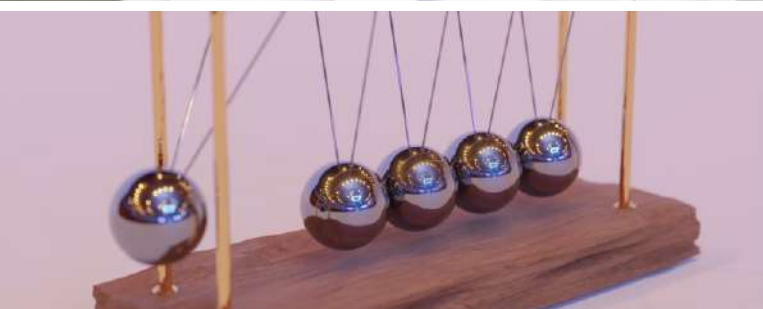

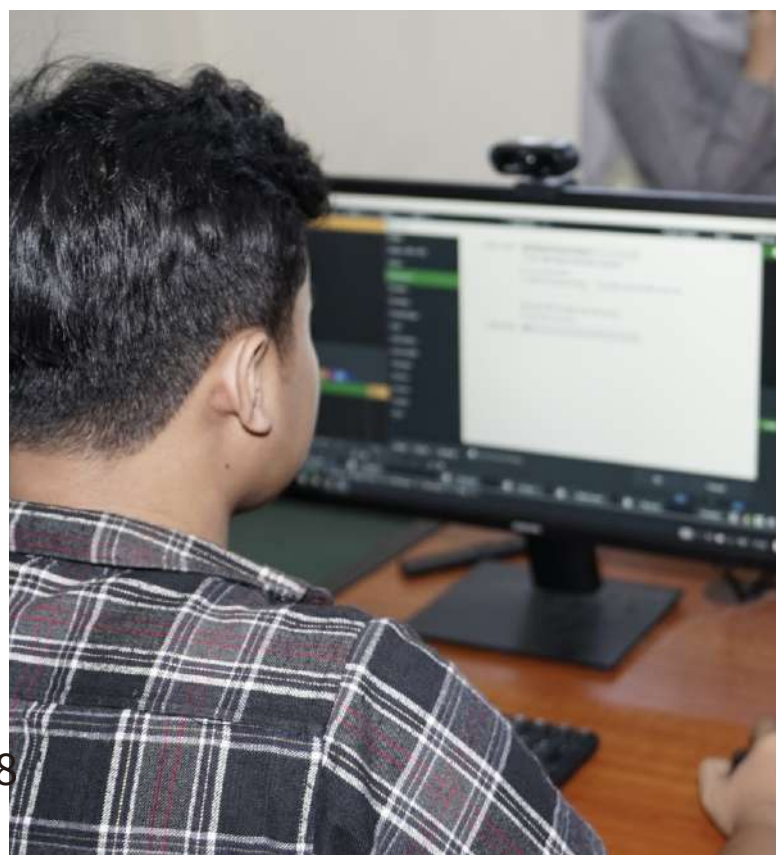

d. Program Mahasiswa Wirausaha (Students' Entrepreneurship Program)

It is a program for students who are interested in entrepreneurship. They compete to get the grant from university of their business idea written in a business plan.



e. Student Community Service / KKN

Student Community Service, is a field-based academic programme designed as a form of community outreach by students for people in specific regions, typically rural areas. It is an implementation of the Three Pillars of Higher Education, specifically the third pillar: community service. In Indonesia, KKN is generally a compulsory requirement for undergraduate students prior to graduation. UPGRIS conducts these programmes independently or in collaboration with various partners, including government agencies, the business and industrial sectors, and non-governmental organisations (NGOs).

Training and Competency Assessment for Students is a professional development programme designed to ensure that students possess skills aligned with industry requirements. This programme is typically integrated into the Diploma Supplement (SKPI). Students will receive both a training certificate and a certificate of competency from the National Professional Certification Agency of the Republic of Indonesia (BNSP). A competency certificate plays a crucial role for students in the modern labour market, serving as valid proof of expertise, enhancing employability, providing skill standardisation, and ensuring professionalism.

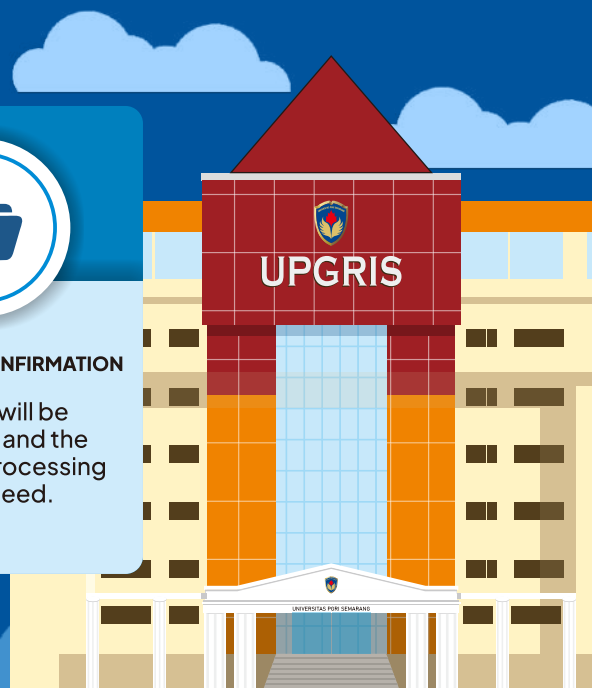

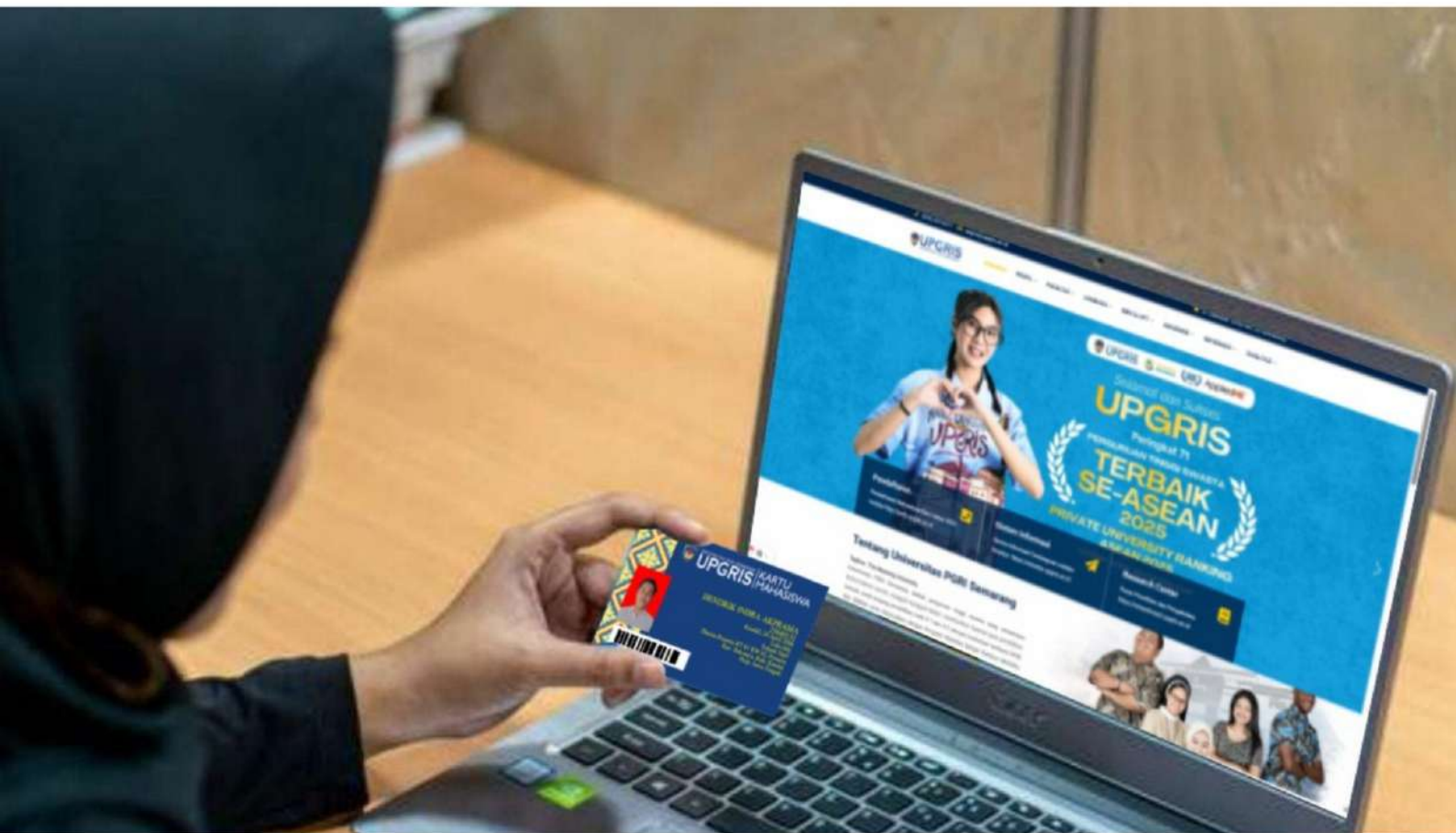

HOW TO GET THE STUDENT CARD

Upon completing enrolment and payment, international students will be registered in the UPGRIS Academic Information System, signifying their official welcome into the UPGRIS family. Subsequently, students will be issued a student ID card (available in both digital and physical formats), which can be collected from the International Office. For further enquiries,

Academic and English Language Criteria and Centre for Bahasa Indonesia and English Teaching

Applicants must hold Paper based TOEFL: 500 or IELTS equivalent

- Undergraduate : Applicants must hold high school diploma
- Postgraduate : Applicants must hold bachelor degree and/or master degree.

English Proficiency Certificate For Bahasa Indonesia Program

International students have to pass an internal Indonesian language tests (written and oral) organized by Bahasa Indonesia for Non-native Speakers (BIPA) UPGRIS. If they do not pass the test, they have to take one semester BIPA program by their own funding.

English Proficiency Certificate For English Program

Minimum score:

- **TOEFL IBT : 64**
- **IELTS : 5.5**
- **TOEFL ITP : 500**
- **TOEIC : 700**

It could be replaced by statement letter by University/School principle which stating that English is used as the medium of instruction.

General Admission Requirements (Non-English Departments)

Indonesian applicants are required to demonstrate English proficiency with a minimum score of TOEFL iBT 32, IELTS 4.0, or TOEFL ITP 400.

International applicants must have completed secondary education equivalent to the Indonesian Senior High School (SMA), demonstrate English proficiency with a minimum score of TOEFL iBT 56, IELTS 5.0, or TOEFL ITP 475, and submit academic transcripts, a valid passport, and a motivation letter. An interview and/or an additional test may be required.

Admission Requirements for the English Department

Indonesian applicants to the English Department are required to demonstrate a higher level of English proficiency with a minimum score of TOEFL iBT 56, IELTS 5.0, or TOEFL ITP 475.

International applicants to the English Department must have completed secondary education equivalent to the Indonesian Senior High School (SMA), demonstrate English proficiency with a minimum score of TOEFL iBT 72, IELTS 6.0, or TOEFL ITP 500, and submit academic transcripts, a valid passport, and a motivation letter. Applicants may also be required to attend an interview and/or take an English placement test.

SCHOLARSHIP

1. The Quran Hafiz Scholarship

is a programme for secondary school graduates (or equivalent) who have memorised the Quran, enabling them to pursue undergraduate studies at Universitas PGRI Semarang. The scholarship provides a tuition fee reduction of up to a maximum of Rp 2,400,000 per semester (Funding amounts may be adjusted according to the current Rector's decree).

2. KIP Kuliah (Indonesia Smart College Card)

KIP Kuliah (Indonesia Smart College Card) is a financial aid programme from the Indonesian government for secondary school graduates (or equivalent) who demonstrate academic or non-academic excellence despite facing financial hardship. Aimed at ensuring access to higher education, the scheme provides full tuition fee waivers (UKT) and a monthly living allowance, alongside mentoring until graduation. This scholarship only for Indonesian Citizens.

3. Physics Education Undergraduate Programme Scholarship

The Physics Education Scholarship is a tuition fee reduction programme awarded to the first five applicants to enrol in the Physics Education undergraduate programme. This scheme is test-free; however, the first five applicants must have a minimum average report card score of 75 from semesters 1 to 4 during Years 10 and 11. Successful candidates will receive a grant of Rp 2,400,000 per semester (the amount of assistance is subject to change in accordance with the applicable Rector's regulations)

WORKING AND WORKER'S RIGHTS

As student visa holder, international students are not allowed to work/earn a living while studying in Indonesia.

PROCEDURE OF GETTING VISA (IMIGRATION)

Visa C9

- For international students with a study/course duration of less than 60 days
- Length of stay: Up to 60 days (extendable)
- Cost: IDR 2,000,000
- Purpose:
 - Benchmarking activities
 - Short courses
 - Short training programs
 - Tourism and visiting friends or family
- Requirements:
 - Comply with Indonesian laws and regulations
 - Respect local customs, culture, and wisdom
 - Have sufficient living expenses during stay in Indonesia

Visa C22A

- For international students undertaking company internship or academic internship
- Length of stay:
 - Up to 60 days (extendable)
 - Up to 180 days (extendable)
- Cost:
 - 60 days: IDR 3,000,000
 - 180 days: IDR 4,000,000
- Purpose:
 - Internship activities to fulfill academic requirements from overseas institutions
 - Tourism and visiting friends or family

Visa E30B (Education Visa)

- Length of stay & cost:
 - Up to 1 year (extendable): IDR 6,000,000
 - Up to 2 years (extendable): IDR 8,500,000

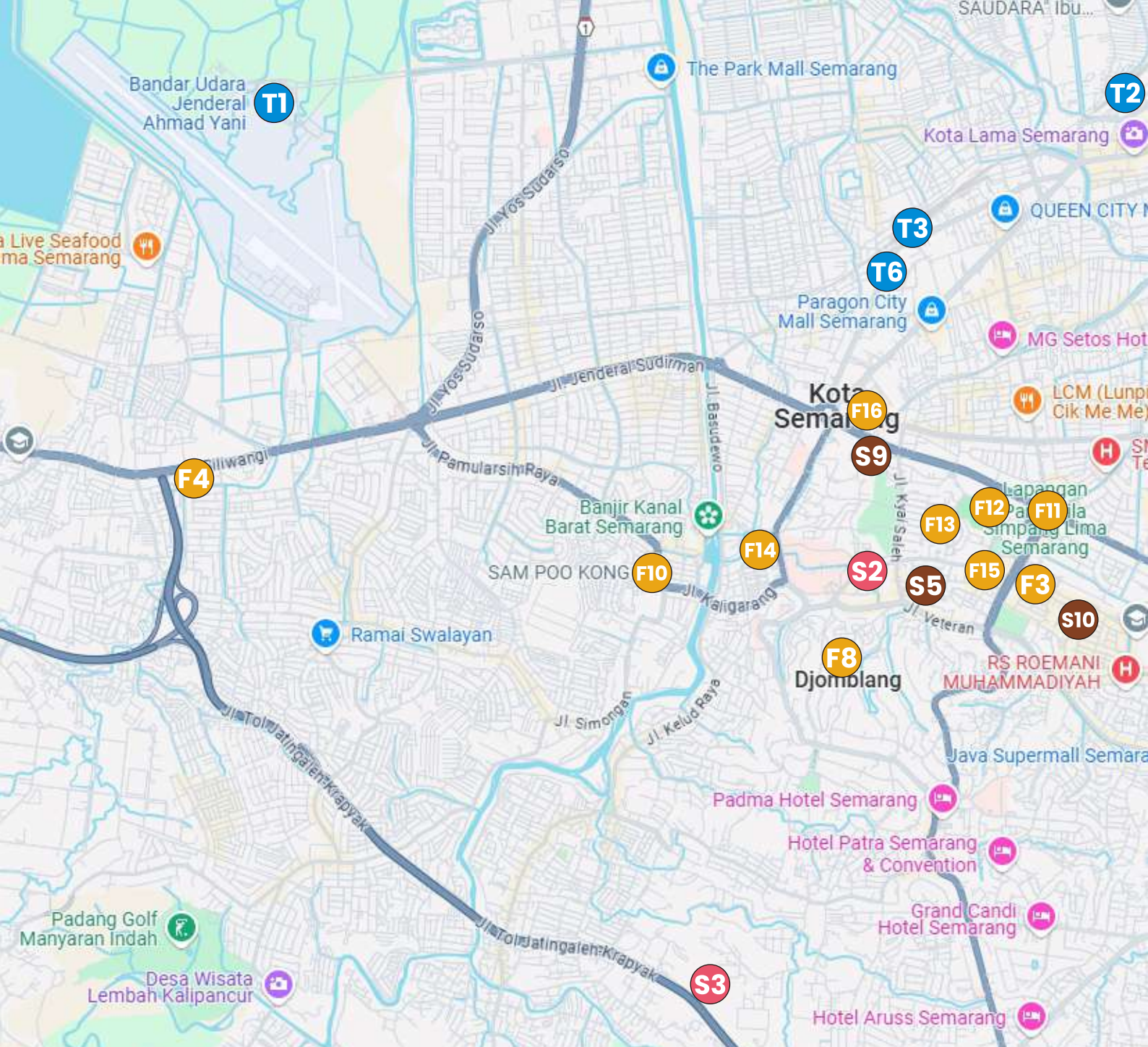

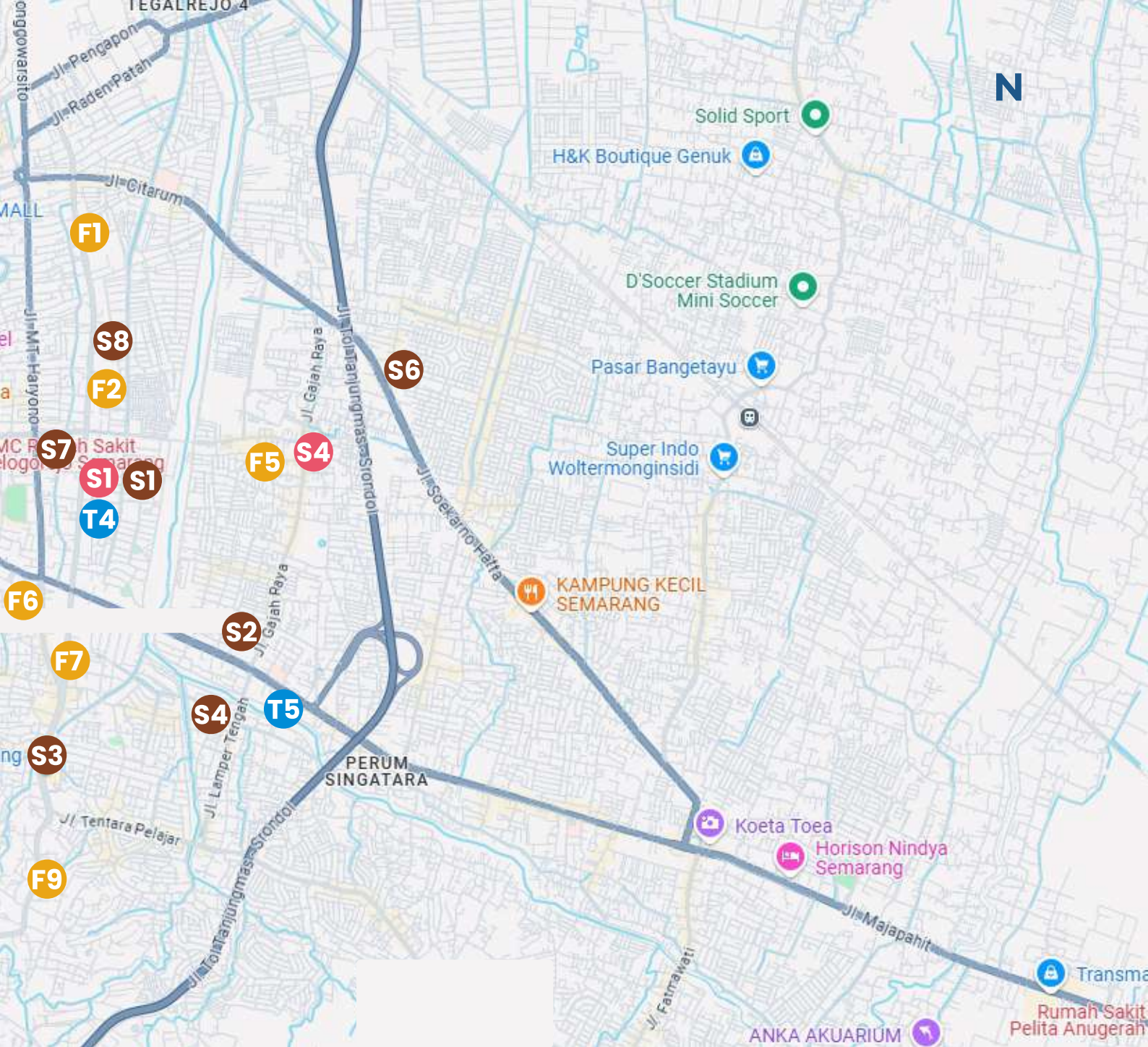
